Dear Mayor Yulin Cruz

I write to invite you to be a special guest speaker at Latino Victory Fund's 2nd Annual Latino Political Summit. The summit will be held on Tuesday, January 30th, 2018, in Washington, D.C., on the day of the State of the Union address. We would also like to invite you to attend a dinner reception that will take place the night before the summit on Monday, January 29th, at 7:00pm at Oyamel. The dinner is a small, but potent gathering comprised of top Latino leaders from across the country.

First held in February of 2017, in the aftermath of the presidential election, the *Latino Political Summit* convened Latino leaders and allies from across the nation to develop a strategy to contain Trump and strengthen Latino power and influence in the process (*New York Times: Hispanic Leaders Plan Fight Against Trump's Agenda*). We hosted Secretary Julián Castro, DNC Chair Tom Perez, DNC Co-Chair Keith Ellison, California Attorney General Xavier Becerra, Members of Congress, and more than 150 elected officials, candidates, community leaders, and activists. We packed the house with enthusiastic Latinos and progressives who, despite the 2016 election results, were energized to push back against hateful rhetoric promoted by President Trump and his allies.

In 2017, we witnessed the enthusiasm turn into action with an unprecedented number of Latinos running for office at all levels of government. In a year wrought with divisive Trumpian rhetoric and policies that threaten the well-being of the Latino community and of the entire nation, we continued to forge ahead and fight. Our candidates were elected in important races in Virginia, Massachusetts, California, Georgia, New York and Florida. Latino Victory was successful in 12 out of 14 races. Some candidates celebrated historic victories, such as Elizabeth Gurman and Ilaia Ayala, who became the first Latinas elected to the Virginia House of Delegates. Our community flexed its political muscle in 2017, and now, we must seize the momentum.

At the 2nd Annual Latino Political Summit, we will discuss and set the vision and strategy for the 2018 midterms and begin the process of building towards the 2020 presidential election. We want to elect more progressive candidates across the nation and continue mobilizing the Latino community to ensure that we elect champions who will stand up for our community and for the democratic values that strengthen our nation.

Mayor Yulin Cruz, you are a fearless leader in our Latino community, and we would be honored if you would join us in this important conversation to help us articulate our 2018 and 2020 vision.
